HISTORICAL NOTE

The Department of Aeronautics was established as one of the administrative departments of the State of Nebraska in 1945 when the Legislature rewrote the Law of 1935, which had created the Aeronautics Commission. The new law provides the department with a director appointed by the governor, with the consent of the Legislature, and for the Nebraska Aeronautics Commission, an advisory commission. When the Aeronautics Commission is in session, the Director of Aeronautics serves as its secretary.

The Advisory Commission is composed of five members and is responsible for supervising and directing the allocation of all state and Federal funds provided for the construction and maintenance of all airports throughout the state. The Commission also designates the site of these airports, and it aids the director in formulating the rules, regulations, and policies to be carried out. The Department has general supervision over aeronautics within the state and is empowered and directed to encourage, foster, and assist in the development of aeronautics. One of the foremost factors in the development of sound aviation is flying safety. This factor is given prime consideration in all acts of the Department.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection consists of the Records of the Nebraska Department of Aeronautics, 1933-1964, arranged in the following subgroups: 1) Correspondence, 2) Publications, 3) Nebraska Aeronautics Association, and 4) Blueprints. Subgroup one is further divided into the following series: 1) Correspondence, 2) Nebraska Airports, and 3) Engineers Correspondence.

This collection relates to the operation of the Nebraska Department of Aeronautics, and to the general subject of aviation in Nebraska. Included within the collection is correspondence from various state agencies, Civil Aeronautics Board Correspondence, Civil Air Patrol Correspondence, Nebraska Aeronautics Commission correspondence and proceedings, and legislative correspondence. Additional material includes: memorandums, reports, news releases, and printed material regarding airports, aviation safety, airlines, and aircraft manufacturers.
