HISTORICAL NOTE

The Nebraska State Horticultural Society was organized September 29, 1869 by “a number of the friends of Horticulture...”, including J. H. Masters, Robert W. Furnas, and Oliver P. Mason. Related material can be found in RG010, records of Governor Furnas.

The stated purpose of the organization was “the promotion of Pomology, Arboriculture, Floriculture, and gardening.”

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This Collection consists of one manuscript box of material arranged in three series: 1) Record Books, 1869-1882; 2) Programs, 1879, 1892; and 3) Miscellaneous.

These records consist mainly of the minutes of the meetings of the Society. They describe its organization and activities.
