HISTORICAL NOTE

These drawings are of St. John's Lutheran Church at Lyons, Nebraska, by Joseph P. Guth, a prominent Omaha Architect. The church was constructed at a cost of \$4,000, May-September 1891. William Hutchinson of Oakland was the contractor. The church was dedicated December 12, 1891. The first structure had a 70' tower. It was burned to the ground December 22, 1901. A second structure was built, modifying the original plans to include a 90' tower. This second church was constructed at a cost of \$6,000 and was dedicated November 2, 1902. The Church is located 4 miles SE of Lyons.
