What will I find in this collection?

RG5599.AM: This collection consists of a scrapbook compiled by Beatrice Lillian (Walker) Lampert. The scrapbook dates from the 1910s-1920s and relates mainly to her high school days in Lincoln, Columbus, Osceola and Omaha, Nebraska and her college days at Mt. Union College in Alliance, Ohio. Materials in the scrapbook include report cards, event programs, ticket stubs, newspaper clippings, photographs, and miscellaneous memorabilia. Also included is information about her brother Lloyd's military service during WWI.
