## **HISTORICAL NOTE**

The Nebraska American Revolution Bicentennial Commission was established by legislative action during the 1972 Session for the purpose of planning, encouraging, developing and coordination the commemorations of the American Revolution and the Bicentennial of the United States of American in 1976. The commission consisted of fifteen members appointed by the Governor for six-year terms. The members were chosen from all areas of the state and represent most major interests.

The commission developed and coordinated plans for the observance of the Nation's 200<sup>th</sup> Birthday in Nebraska. There were 93 county chairmen and a 33-member advisory council to assist the commission in developing bicentennial programs and activities.

Don Searcy served as the executive director and Mrs. Eleanor Crosier as the deputy director.
