HISTORICAL RECORD

Located in northeastern Nebraska, Burt County figures prominently in the early history of the state, with its rich tributaries which were claimed by white settlers in the early 1850's. Until then, the Omaha, Winnebago and Ponca Indians hunted in the prairies and river valleys, occasionally raided by Sioux along the west side of the Missouri River in 1804. Trappers, mainly French, had taken most of the furred animals by the time F. E. Lange's party settled in Golden Spring (now Golden), Burt County in 1853.

A treaty with the Omaha Indians in 1854 allowed both for white settlement and an Indian reservation of 300,000 acres. The first election and official organization of Burt County occurred in December of 1854. All who had taken an oath that they intended to make Nebraska their future home were allowed to vote. At this election Burt and Blackbird County (later Thurston) were joined. Later, in 1889, Thurston County was separated from Burt and the Indian reservation remains a part of that county. Logan Fontanelle, regarded by some as the last "chief" of the Omaha, and by others as an interpreter in the original treaty negotiations, was instrumental in opening up the area to white settlement. His father was a French trader and his mother an Omaha Indian. A creek in the county is named after him, Logan Creek.

In the next year, Benjamin R. Folsom and party from Utica, New York, came into the wooded valleys with sandstone quarries, and seeing the building and agricultural possibilities, laid claim to lands around what was Tekama (later Tekamah). Until then an Indian camping ground, Tekamah became the county seat at the organization of the county. The original town was surveyed in 1854 and platted in 1855 (incorporated March 14, 1855). The U.S. Government survey was not completed into Burt County until 1857. Benjamin Folsom purchased the town site from the Government in 1859.

The first official meetings in the county were held at the Harrington Hotel, 1858-1861. In the latter year the county leased a house from J. R. Hide for county offices. Offices were located in Thomas Hall, owned by Tekamah Building Company, Block 147 until the courthouse, located on lots 3-4, Block 90, Tekamah was deeded to the county in January 1878. In 1917 a new courthouse was erected on the same site.

The first school was held in the W. B. Newton home in Tekamah in 1857 and taught by Newton. Later classes were conducted out of the same quarters for the courthouse. The first schoolhouse, 20x30 feet, was built in 1867 at the foot of the Missouri Bluffs on the north side of Tekamah Creek. In 1882 a two-story brick building replaced this one and in 1894 the Tekamah Public School officially became School District #1, Burt County. Today (1994) there are six school districts in the county. In 2006 there are 12 school districts.

Burt County is named in honor of Francis Burt, the first Territorial Governor of Nebraska. Originally the larger of eight Nebraska counties, its present boundaries were fixed in February of 1879. The county now encompasses 493 square miles and is bordered on the north by Thurston County and the Indian reservation, on the east by the Missouri River, on the south by Washington and Dodge counties and on the west by Dodge and Cuming counties.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This record group consists of the records of Burt County, Nebraska arranged into nine subgroups: 1) County Treasurer, 1864-1915; 2) Assessment Records, 1880-1945; 3) County Board of Commissioners, 1857-1963; 4) County Clerk, 1858-1995; 5) Register of Deeds, 1857-1914; 6) County Court, 1857-1927; 7) District Court, 1868-1973; 8) Superintendent of Schools (no records); and 9) School Districts, 1861-1920.

Subgroup One, County Treasurer is divided into six series: 1) Tax Lists, 1864-1915; 2) Delinquent and Tax Sale Records, 1863-1920; 3) Motor Vehicle Tax Lists (no records); 4) Special Tax Assessments, 1883-1893; and 5) Miscellaneous volumes, 1897-1898, 1910-1912; and 6) School Land Records, 1868-1913

Series One includes personal property and real estate valuations for county as a whole as well as volumes for township, villages, and city valuations. Series Two consists of Delinquent Tax Lists and a Tax Sale Record, 1863-1871. There are no volumes currently in storage for Series Three, Motor Vehicle Tax Lists. Series Four consists of a single volume of Ditch Improvement Assessments 1883-1895. Series Five includes a volume used as a township treasurer's cash book, 1897-1898 and then used by the county treasurer as a general fund ledger, 1910-1912; a tax list correction volume, 1865-1881 and a Motor Vehicle Register, 1911-1920.

The bulk of the collection is contained in Subgroup Two, Assessor. Included are volumes for both real estate and personal assessments 1880-1945. This subgroup is on 100 reels of microfilm in the reference room at 1500 R Street under RG205.

The County Board Proceedings of Subgroup Three are microfilmed and shelved in the reference room. This subgroup contains the minutes of meetings of the County Board of Commissioners, 1858-1963 on film and a single volume which records land claims of the Burt County Claim Association, commissioner's proceedings, and estray notices, 1857-1861. The latter volume is not on microfilm and

is shelved with the collection at our K Street facility. Original volumes of proceedings remain at the county.

Subgroup Four, County Clerk, 1857-1995, is divided into five series: 1) Marriage Records, 1861-1995; 2) Election Records, 1880-1952; 3) Bond Records, 1871-1958; 4) Professional Registers, 1881-1891; and 5) Miscellaneous.

Series One, Marriage Records, includes a general index to marriages, 1887-1995; marriage docket, V.1 through V.15; and a territorial marriage volume, 1861-1871. Volumes 1 through 14 have indexes in the front of each volume. The collection was microfilmed by the Genealogical Society of Utah in August of 1995 in cooperation with the Historical Society. Original records remain at the county courthouse. The Election records of Series Two include three volumes relating to county elections, 1880-1916. One volume includes records of primary elections, 1907-1930; and one volume records Abstracts of Votes Case at general, primary and special elections, 1916-1952. Series Three records county bond records, 1871-1958. Series Four contains a single volume registering certificates issued to physicians in Burt County, 1881-1891. Series Four includes a brand and livestock record, 1858-1881 and a fee book registering amounts paid for filing instruments, 1881-1882 and individual accounts at the end of the volume is recorded in Series Five.

Subgroup Five, Register of Deeds, 1857-1914, is divided into eight series: 1) General Index to Deeds (no record); 2) Numerical Indexes, 1857-1901; 3) Deed Record (no record); 4) Miscellaneous Record, 1874-1892; 5) Mortgage Records, 1881-1914; 6) Miscellany, 1888-1893; and 7) County Surveyor, n.d.

Grantee/Grantor indexes, 1857-1881. and numerical index volumes, 1866-1901 are identified together. Patrons must contact the county for General Index to Deeds and Deed Records. Series Five includes seven volumes of General Index to Mortgages, 1881-1914. Series Six includes an Index to Instruments files, 1888-1893; and series Seven, field notes of irregular tracts by the county surveyor.

Subgroup Six, County Court, 1847-1927, is divided into five series: 1) Probate Records, 1857-1898; 2) Trial Dockets and Calendars, 1876-1918; 3) Civil and Criminal Dockets, 1873-1927; 4) Justice Dockets, 1873-1890; and 5) Miscellaneous, 1898-1913

The bulk of probate records for Burt County remain at the county courthouse. We have Records covering the years 1858-1898 divided into five series: 1) General Index to Probate; 2) Entry Books, 1858-1895; Estate Records, 1878-1895; Administrative Records, 1870-1898. Probate Dockets remain at the county courthouse. We have 2 index volumes, 1858-1896, as well as entry and estate records, 1858-1895. There is and Administrative Record, 1870-1898 and Inventory & Sale Bill Record, 1873-1887. These records have been microfilmed by the Genealogical Society of Utah and will be available in the reference room in the near future. Series Two contains a Trial Calendar for Probate Court but registers civil cases only and does not relate to probate matters. Series Four contains civil dockets of the county court labeled on spine Justice Dockets and Judge's Dockets as well as civil dockets. They are described in this series because they follow chronologically.

Subgroup Seven, District Court, 1858-1973, is divided into ten series: 1) Naturalization Records, 1868-1943; 2) General Index (no record); 3) Appearance Dockets, 1868-1939; 4) Daily Journals, 1861-1964; 5) Complete Record, 1867-1936; 6) Civil and Criminal Case Files, 1892-1973; 7) Judgement and Execution Dockets, 1872-1936; 8) State Tax Suit, 1905-1919; 9) Commissioners of Insanity, 1898-1915; and 10) Miscellaneous Records, 1872-1910.

Series One is microfilmed and available in the reference room under RG205. There is a card index to naturalizations as well as declarations of intention, naturalization records, and petition and record volumes, 1906-1943. The remaining series records have not been inventoried to the volume level and must be requested from our K Street facility.

There are not records currently in storage for Subgroup Eight, Superintendent of Schools. This includes the county school census which remains at the county level. Contact the county clerk for access to this record.

Subgroup Nine, School District Records, is arranged in two series: 1) School District #6, 1861-1907; and 2) School District #50, 1884-1920.

Series One contains a single record book for School District #6 on one reel of microfilm shelved in the Reference Room under RG205. It is for Decatur School. This district was previously subdistrict #1, 1861-1867. Included in the volume are school censuses, minutes of meetings, school district orders, and fiscal records, 1861-1907. Some entries in the volume relate to Subdistrict #2, Silver Creek.

School District #50 records, 1884-1920, are not on microfilm and must be requested from K Street. They include director's records and annual reports of the director, 1894-1915; school district record Books, 1887-1911; school census records, 1884-1919; Teacher's Contracts, 1886-1920; and miscellaneous correspondence, agreements, and invoices. The laws of Nebraska restrict the Teacher's Grade and Classification records, 1890-1911 of this series.

The majority of Burt County records were transferred to the State Archives in 1972. Volumes #1 & #2 of the Commissioners Proceedings were loaned for filming in 1957, the remainder were loaned at the time of the transfer of Burt County records in 1972. Marriage Records were microfilmed by the Genealogical Society of Utah in 1995 and the probate records were filmed by them in 1999. School District #6 record was loaned for filming by the county Superintendent of Schools. Assessment Records were transferred in 1972 and were microfilmed by Records Management Division of the Secretary of State's office for the Historical Society in 1991. The naturalization records were accessioned by the Archives in 1992 and microfilmed at the Historical Society by the Genealogical Society of Utah in November 1994. We still hold the original naturalization records. Additional records were received in 1992.
