HISTORICAL SKETCH

The dustpan dredge, Captain Meriwether Lewis, was constructed by the Marietta Manufacturing Company of Point Pleasant, West Virgina, in 1931. It first saw service on the Missouri River at Cambridge Bend in May of the following year. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' vessel was most heavily utilized during Missouri River channel stabilization efforts from the mid-1940s through the mid-1960s. Approximately 269 feet long and 85 feet wide, it accommodated an operating crew of over fifty persons and possessed the capacity to dredge over 100,000 cubic yards daily.

By the late 1960's, the vessel was used only sparingly. Its final dredging job was at Florence Boat Basin north of Omaha during April-May 1969. The boat was subsequently mothballed at the Corps. of Engineers' boatyard, Gasconade, Missouri. During the summer of 1976, the Dredge Lewis was donated to the Nebraska State Historical Society by the Federal government. In April of the following year, the vessel was towed to Brownville, Nebraska, and eventually drydocked. It was dedicated as the Museum of Missouri River History on June 7, 1981, and served in this capacity over the next five years. In early 1987, ongoing excessive maintainence costs forced the Historical Society to close the branch museum facility and relinquish the vessel to local interests in Brownville.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection is comprised of records relating to the dredge, Captain Meriwether Lewis, and is arranged in nine series: 1) Administrative Records, 1933-1967; 2) Personnel Records, 1950-1965; Log Books, 1943-1965; 4) Reports of Operation, 1953-1964; 5) Time Books, 1943-1965; 6) Reports, 1954-1967; 7) Printed Matter, 1930's-1970's; 8) Miscellany, 1948-1966; and 9) Maps, Drawings, Specifications, and Technical Manuals, 1901-1965.

The bulk of this collection consists of the oversize drawings relating to the construction of the dredge by Marietta Manufacturing Company, 1928-1934 and later revisions made by the

U.S. Corps of Engineers, 1935-1965. These drawings are included in Series Nine and are stored in oversize storage in the headquarters building. A separate inventory and index to these drawings follows the regular inventory of this record group. Drawings include profiles of Missouri River Surveys, 1949-1964.

Additional Records for the Dredge Lewis, 1976-1988, may be found in RG14, Nebraska State Historical Society collection, SG5, Branch Museums, Series 2, Branch Museum Records. Oversize drawings relating to improvements & restoration, 1977-1987, are a part of that record group. For relevant Missouri River Surveys, see also RG3, Attorney General, Nebraska v. Iowa oversize drawings.

The records of this collection illustrate ongoing operations of the vessel as a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers dredge during the 1940's through the 1960's. Specifically, the first series: 1) Administrative Records, 1933-1967, contains numerous federal directives and memos that outline policy and guidelines for successful operation. Also included are various accounting records and correspondence, 1961-1965. Records of this Series added in March of 1990, Box 1, include additions to records previously inventoried under Series 6, Reports.

Series Two, 2) Personnel Records, 1950-1965, essentially consist of time and attendance reports, labor reports, and performance appraisals for various crew members.

Series Three, 3) Log Books, 1945-1969, is further subdivided into three subseries: 1) Engineer's Logs, 1945-1960; 2) Engineer's Logs by Watch, 1947-1964; and 3) Captain's Logs, 1946-1969. All of the subseries contain bound volumes that include specific entries describing daily operations of the boat. Further insights into the latter are provided by the records contained in Series Four, 4) Reports of Operation, 1953-1964, and 5) Time Books, 1943-1965. Series Four, Reports of Operations is further divided into three subseries: 1) Daily Reports of Operations, 1953-1964; 2) Monthly Reports of Operations, 1953-1964; and 3) Shift Reports, April - November 1965.

Series Six, 6) Reports, 1954-1967 include reports on repairs, 1954-1964; Requisitions, 1962-1963, Water Tests & channel reports, 1964-1969, and work orders, 1963-1965. See Box 1 for additional records relating to this series added March, 1990.

Series Seven, 7) includes rules and regulations manuals and parts catalogs, 1930's-1970's.

Series Eight, 8) Miscellany, 1948-1966, includes miscellaneous bulletins and information brochures.
