HISTORICAL NOTE

Nebraska Territory received a total of 89,140.21 acres of land from the federal government in the initial land grant of 1864. This included lands for the common schools, erection of public buildings and a penitentiary, land for the university and sections of saline lands. By 1873, nearly one-half of land set aside for state purposes had been sold and the remainder by 1878. The major portion of internal improvement lands was absorbed by the railroads. The state did not begin selling Agricultural Lands until 1880.

Saline lands were granted for the use of the state and by the act of 1864 directed to be disposed of by the Legislature. Nearly 15,104 acres of the original 48,893.97 went to the normal school at Peru, the model farm, the hospital for the insane at Lincoln, the university, and for Lincoln city lots. The first major sale of state lands included these lots.

School lands prior to statehood were administered by the Territorial Commissioner of Common Schools under provisions of an act of the Territorial Legislature in 1860. He acted under the supervision of the Legislature. The first Nebraska statute for the control of educational lands came after statehood, and by this act the state auditor was appointed the land commissioner in charge of administration of these lands. This is when the school land ledgers and abstracts were begun at the county level. The county commissioners of each county supervised the sale and lease of the property.

The Nebraska State Constitution of 1875 provided for the organization of a board, the Board of Educational Lands and Funds, responsible for the sale, lease, and general management of all lands and funds set apart for educational purposes. By that same constitution, the Board of Public Lands and Buildings was formed to supervise and control all buildings, grounds and lands of the state, the state prison, asylums and all other institutions.

In 1897, A. E. Sheldon, legislative representative from Dawes County, introduced a bill repealing the former school land law and revising it to stop the further sale of school lands and set up a perpetual leasing system to provide for a permanent trust fund for educational purposes. The act was passed the same year. attempts to repeal this law and provide for the sale of the remaining school lands, this act remained in effect thru 1937.

The early Board of Public Lands and Buildings governed all state, educational, and saline lands in Nebraska. This included governance of the institutions existing on these lands. By constitutional amendment in 1912, the duties relating to purchase and supplies and governance of state institutions was transferred to the Dept. of Public Institutions. Later, an act was signed April 21, 1913, transferring the duties of the Board of Public Lands and Buildings to the Board of Educational Lands and Funds.

Today the board, not headed by a Commissioner, consists of five members appointed by the governor and approved by the legislature to serve five-year terms. The Board manages more than 1.5 million acres held in trust for Nebraska's public schools. It issues surface and subsurface leases for use of school land. Income received from the sale & leases of school land is distributed to public schools by the Legislature. The Board of Educational Lands and Funds is governed by trust law and operates as a non-partisan and non-political entity.

The state laws of 1903 required the board to appoint a state surveyor who takes charge of field notes, maps, charts and records of United States surveys; issues instructions to county surveyors; settles boundary disputes. The State Surveyor is a member of the Nebraska Boundary Commission and stores all survey maps and records for the state of Nebraska. These surveys are microfilmed annually and the security microfilm is stored with the State Archives.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

Collection consists of the records of the Board of Educational Lands and Funds and its predecessors relating to the supervision of school, educational, and saline lands in Nebraska, 1867-1958. collection is arranged into eight subgroups: 1) Minutes and Annual Reports, 1877-1935; 2) Commissioner of Public Lands and Buildings, 1886-1937; 3) Board of Educational Lands & Funds, 1938-current; 4) State Surveyor, 1903-1950; 5) State, Saline, and University Lands, 1864-1954; 6) School Land Records, 1868-1954; 7) Financial Records, 1870-1958; and 8) Legal Cases, 1891-1971.

Subgroup One, Minutes, 1877-1913, are restricted to staff use only due to the presence of actions taken by the board regarding inmates of the state institutions. Minutes, 1913-1971 are on security microfilm stored with the State Archives. Permission to copy minutes after 1913 should be obtained from the Board. This subgroup also contains draft copies of minutes and miscellaneous annual reports of the Board. Included are miscellaneous resolutions, 1934-1935, and semi-annual reports of institutions, 1911-1912.

Subgroup Two contains the correspondence and documents from the office of Commissioner of Public Lands and Buildings, 1867-1937. Series Two of this subgroup contains specifications and contracts relating to construction and remodeling of state institutions, and general correspondence relating to administration of these facilities. included in this subgroup is correspondence & records of the Board of Purchase and Supply, 1893-1923.

Subgroup Three, Board of Educational Lands and Funds, is basically a subgroup open for future transfers. Presently included are miscellaneous records existing in the original transfer for the period after 1937.

Subgroup Four, State Surveyor, contains correspondence, 1903-1950, and surveying records of this office. Exhibits prepared by the State Surveyor for litigation may be found in the last subgroup.

Subgroup Five, State, Saline, and University Lands, contains records regarding administration and disposition of these lands. Included are inventories, deed records, and ledgers pertaining to the original land grant from the government for such purposes. land records include lease and sale records for this land.

Subgroup Six, School Land Records, 1868-1954, contains the majority holdings for this collection. Included are county school land abstracts of deeds and sales, tract books, and indexes to school lands. correspondence relates to school land leases and sales, 1926-1937. school land records of series four list purchasers and leasers of school The indexes of series three include names, location of land,

type of land, amount of purchase, bill of sale number, and date Since the county commissioners were responsible for the disposition and leasing of these lands, many records still remain in the records of the individual counties. The State Archives holds some of these records and they may be found with the records of the individual county treasurer's.

Subgroup Seven, Financial Records, 1870-1958, include audit reports, check vouchers and registers. Of particular interest in Subgroup Eight, Legal Matters, is the correspondence relating to contested homestead claims, 1896-1903. The majority of the remaining miscellaneous records consists of some transcripts of hearings regarding school land reappraisal in 1954.

Series Two of this subgroup contains all legal papers and research relating to the boundary dispute and subsequent litigation of Nebraska vs. Iowa. Included are numerous exhibits tracing Missouri River history from 1852-1964 and valuable documentation relating to the islands in the river. There were over 2000 exhibits used in this law suit. Exhibits include negatives, transparencies, aerial photos, blue line & mylar maps & drawings, U.S. Government river surveys, and exhibits prepared by the Nebraska State Surveyor for this case.

Additional School Land records to current time can be found in the records of individual county treasurer's and clerk's offices.
