HISTORICAL NOTE

The Fire Commission was created by the Legislature in 1909. The Governor, who served as Fire Commissioner, appointed two deputies to manage the office. These duties were transferred to the Division of Fire Prevention in the Department of Trade and Commerce by the Civil Administration Code of 1919. Legislation in 1925 provided for the appointment of a State Fire Marshal by the Governor. When the Department of Trade and Commerce was abolished in 1933, the agency became a part of the Department of Insurance. Later in 1974 it was placed under the supervision of the Governor.

Duties of the Fire Marshal's office include inspecting buildings, examining scenes of fires to determine origin, regulating combustible and explosive materials and delapidated buildings, promulgating rules and regulations and adopting safety standards for fire prevention and protection, enforcing handicapped standards, and enforcing the underground storage tank program in conjunction with the Dept. of Environmental Control.

The State Fire Marshal is partially funded by taxes paid by fire insurance companies operating in the state.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection consists of the records of the State Fire Marshal's office, 1909-current, arranged into seven series: 1) County Files, 1909-1949; 2) Town Files, 1950-1993; 3) Fire Investigation Reports, 1952-1993; 4) Photo File, 1972-1980; 5) Incident Reports, 1973-1993; 6) Annual Reports, 1910-1966; and 7) Project 20/20 Files

Series One, County Files, 1909-1949, include the earliest fire investigation reports accessioned by the Archives. This

series is arranged in two parts: Part 1 (1909-1930) and Part 2 (1931-1949). Part one contains individual files for each fire arranged by county then towns (alpha) and alphabetical by owner, occupant, or suspect within towns. Part two is basically chronological folders containing all reports for the time period listed. In some cases individual folders are filed with chronological folders. These cases are listed separately on the inventory.

Series Two, Town Files, 1950-1993, contain corres. and records concerning fires by towns. Each fire has its own file.

Series Three, Photo File, contains evidential photos taken at the scene of fires. Also included are instructional photos and photos of fire school & station events.

Series Four, Fire Investigation Reports, contain the same information as may appear in series one and two but for later years, 1974-1993. Fires are arranged in individual folders by case numbers. Included in Series Three (B.1-4) are fire investigation forms filed in volumes chronologically, 1952-1974. These forms may duplicate forms filed in individual case file folders. Also included are reports made to the National Fire Protection Association for fires in which a death or casualty resulted, 1972-1974.

Series Five, 1973-1993, contains preliminary and incident reports of fires which may or may not have further information in the investigative files. Files are arranged by year and by case numbers corresponding with the investigative files.

Series Six contains the annual reports of the State Fire Marshal's office on microfilm, 1910-1966. These reports were loaned for microfilming by the Fire Marshal's office in 1968 and later accessioned into our library (1977). Later reports may also be found in our library department.

Series Seven, Project 20/20 Files, contains minutes, reports, etc. for the "Demonstration Project Emergency Notification, Dispatch, and Assistance Program for Highway Accident Victims," in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration. The State Fire Marshal was a member of the Board.
