HISTORICAL NOTE

The first authority to regulate public health in Nebraska was given to individual municipalities in the state in 1869. A new criminal code of 1873 related in part to offenses against public health. The second effort to regulate the practice of medicine was in 1881 when an act passed by the Legislature required physicians to register their qualifications with county officials. Similar requirements were made for the practice of dentistry in 1887.

The original law forming the State Board of Health was enacted in 1891. This law was amended in 1903 to provide for a State Health Inspector. The Board of Health was composed of the governor, attorney general and supt of public instruction. The board was empowered to grant and revoke licenses for the practice of medicine and surgery, dentistry, and nursing; to supervise all matters relating to the protection of people from contagious, infectious and epidemic diseases; to license maternity homes; to appoint boards of examiners for professional medical persons; and to operate a bacteriological laboratory

The Department of Public Welfare gained supervision and control over matters relating to public health by the Civil Administration Code of 1919. This new organization created the Bureau of Examining Boards under the authority of the Department of Public Welfare. All members of the different boards of the Bureau were appointed by that department. Prior to 1927 there were ten groups of examiners each of which had a separate practice act. After control of these boards was transferred to the Department of Public Welfare, the ten groups were recodified in the Uniform Licensure Law of 1927 to be regulated by one act. That act also provided for the annual renewal of all licenses in Nebraska.

The Board of Pharmacy was created in 1887 to examine applicants for pharmacists' licenses and register. Members were the attorney general, secretary of state, auditor, treasurer, and commissioner of public lands and buildings.

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In 1899 the Board of Embalmers was established to examine and certify embalmers. This board was appointed by the state board of health. The legislature of 1931 required all funeral directors and undertakers in Nebraska to register.

The Legislature of 1901 provided for the certification of osteopaths by the state board of health. In 1909 the state board of osteopathy was formed consisting of the governor and five examiners appointed by the governor to examine and certify persons desiring to practice osteopathy.

An act approved April 3, 1903 required the state board of health to examine all applicants for certification as physicians. Prior to this time physicians were required to hold a diploma for registration in Nebraska. The legislature of 1917 passed a law reorganizing the health department and created an advisory board to conduct examinations for licenses to practice medicine.

The Board of Dental Secretaries was created by the legislature in 1905. It consisted of five dentists appointed by the state board of health for terms of five years. Their duty is to examine, certify and register all dentists in Nebraska.

Another Board created in 1905 was the Board of Veterinarians, later of the Board of Veterinarian Medicine and Surgery.

The Board of Optometry was created by the legislature of 1907. It consists of three examiners appointed by the governor for terms of three years.

The Board of Examiners of nurses was created by the 1909 legislature and members were appointed by the state board of health. The legislature of 1935 eliminated the nursing profession from the Uniform Licensure Act and set up a Bureau of Education and Registration of Nurses within the Department of Education under the supervision of the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

The Board of Chiropractic was created by the legislature of 1915.

The 1919 legislature established the Board of Chiropody.

The Basic Sciences Act was passed in 1927 requiring candidates applying for a license to practice the healing arts to be certified by a Basic Science Board before taking a license examination. The certificate related to Chiropractic, Osteopathy, and Medicine and Surgery, and covered the subjects of anatomy, physiology, chemistry, bacteriology, pathology, and hygiene.

The Board of Barber Examiners was also created by the 1927 legislature under the supervision of the Department of Public Welfare. The law was amended in 1929 to include all those who cut hair to hold haircutters licenses.

The Board of Cosmetology Examiners was created January 1, 1930.

The Board of Examiners for Architects and Engineers was established in 1937. See RG081 for records.

From 1953 to 1981, the Department of Health was governed by a Board of Health appointed by the governor. The 1981 Legislature passed a law defining the role of the 15 member Board of Health as the Bureau of Examining Boards.

From 1981 to the present time. The sole role of the Board of Health has been to govern the Bureau of Examining Boards. The Department of Health is no longer governed by a board and is headed by a Director.

> The following volumes are minutes of the Nebraska NOTE: State Board of Health and include actions taken by the Board regarding licenses to practice medicine in Nebraska, 1903-1935. By a legislative act April 3, 1903, the state board of health was required to examine all applicants for certification as physicians. By a legislative act in 1905, maternity homes and boarding homes for infants came under the jurisdiction of the board. The board was known as the Secretaries to the State Board of Health until July 23, 1917. It then became the Advisory Board to the Nebraska State Board of Health and was organized as such July 24, 1917. It was again reorganized as the Board of Medical Examiners in November 1918 and became a part of the Department of Public Welfare. This board held its 1st meeting November 13, 1919 and continues through the period of these minutes, January 8, 1935.
