Summary: Nebraska Senator George William Norris, Chairman Senate Judiciary Committee; Texas Congressman Hatton W. Summers, Chairman House and Judiciary Committee; and New Jersey Senator William Warren Barbour. Legislators speaking on kidnapping and murder of son of aviator Charles Augustus Lindbergh. CU Norris, CU Summers, CU Barbour.

5. Story Title: Stratosphere Flight Ends in Crash. Date: July 28, 1934. Location: Looms, Nebraska. Summary: Military balloon rack up. Crowd around wreckage. Sergeant Bishop, responsible for groundwork, inspects instruments with Army Lieutenant Major Kepner. Takeoff preparation by Anderson, Kepner, and Captain Stevens; Balloon in flight. Copilot Captain Anderson sitting on balloon. Standing L to R: Anderson with Copper of Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company. CU Anderson. 13. Story Title: Governors Confer on Drought Relief. Date: August 15, 1930. Location: Washington, District of Columbia. Summary: State executives hold conference to cooperate with President Hoover. Politicians L to R: H.S. Caufield of Missouri, John Hammill of Iowa, John Weaver of Nebraska, John E. Erickson of Montana, Harry S. Leslie of Indiana, Meyers T. Cooper of Ohio; Meeting occurred during the Great Depression.

Eugene Eppley presenting trophy. CU Israel speaking. Stunt flying by Marcellus King and Milo Burcham. Lee Miles crossing finish line. CU Israel speaking.
16. Story Title: Dogs in the Army. Date: May 11-14, 1943. Location: Fort Robinson, Nebraska. Summary: War use of dogs. Obstacle course. Coast Guard dogs attacking man as he fires gun. Walking with trainer. CU Soldier and German Shepard. Men cooking. Animals training include: Collies, Dalmatians, Shepards, Doberman pinschers. Dogs barking. Being Groomed.
