What will I find in this collection?

RG5684.AM: This collection consists of 24 pages of typed reminiscences of Gladys Marie McKeehan Haughn from an interview conducted by Kathy Haughn Stautberg in 1984. The reminiscences mainly cover the period from 1904-1950s and describe life in Omaha, Linwood and Fremont, Nebraska, as well as Casper, Wyoming. Of special interest are her descriptions of Mount St. Mary's Seminary Boarding School in Omaha, life during the Great Depression, and various happenings around Linwood, Nebraska. Also included are photocopies (5 pages) of a few family photographs and some genealogical information.
