"Things were really 'jumpin' at Cotner Terrace last Monday evening," reported *Gold Tips*, the Gold's employee newsletter, on May 11, 1957. The long-time downtown Lincoln retailer had a Fifteen-Year Club into which employees were initiated after fifteen years with the company. The circus-themed

1957 banquet honored nineteen employees, who were "full of vim and vigor and had the Initiating Committee thoroughly 'bushed' before the evening was over." Even better, "the entertainment committee... arranged a Rock'n Roll program which had clubbers jumpin' and squealing."
