Dear Sir:

I have followed in an interested way the Starkweather trial. As far as I can see, the trial was a very fair one, both sides presented their cases well, and the verdict reached, in my opinion, a reasonable one.

Our World-Herald states that you have until June 10 to move for a new trial.

The reason I am writing you is to attempt to dissuade you from any such move, or from any move to have the case reviewed by either our State Supreme Court, or the United States Supreme Court.

My reasons are first, that I believe you made a very able and thorough defence for your client. You have come through with an enhanced reputation as a lawyer and as a defence lawyer. Your potential clientele must have increased geometrically. And I think any further prosecution by you of this defence would be anti-climactic. It would not add one whit to your reputation now - in fact, I think it would detract from it.

Second, I believe I am stating a fact when I say that 98% of the people in this neighborhood applaud the result of the trial. They believe that Starkweather got exactly what he deserves. And if you carry the case on, you will have this 98% against you right from the start. And should you get a new trial, or a reprieve or commutation of any sort, you would still have that 98% against you. That is the way I would feel.

In short, you have done a good job. Don't spoil it

now!



I nave kept a cony of all the Sious City Journal of May 7th and from Judge Spencers picture. I really feel that God gave you one of the most honorable men that ever held the position as a judge. Above his picture is this, "Judge Thinke Publicity Hurts Trial".

I have found a book with a story, Something Worth Looking Into". I am sending this under separate cover. After this young man received the death setence, his own Father, said We should all go out and ert a good steak". Another time when either of you asked him if he thought his son was insane when he did those things, he said, He didn't use good judgement". From these remarks I truly believe that if his Fathers family record was looked into, there would be insanity found. As for his Mother, my heart goes out to her. She was likely ruled by this smart cracking husband of hers. I don't remember of seeing any article of the family belonging to any Religion, but they may have. A little Religion goes a long ways, for if ywe have God on our side we can be happy working at any meager task, and wouldn't think of harming anyone. The reporter that wrote an article about Starkweather always wanting to be somebody, shouldn't of made that statement, for if he did, he wouldn't of commit those terrible crimes.


