got Postage for Post office of P.M. at 50 cents
Postage for 1000 00 He charged
at 1 cent & got 1000 at 8 00 very

Jan 6 Sunday

Don chores I went to Creek got barrel of flour wrote out Post Office Papers at night 120 Preaching at School House. Cold & Pleasant.

Jan 7 Monday

Don chores about Home settled with Chesley Bentwell owed him 1 dollar per month sent for the blade for him.

Received \$1.65 of G.W. Kibler for the blade Bowes here in evening with Kimble

I arrived at 10 O'clock. cold & windy.

Jan 8 Tuesday

Don chores then went to Mr. Rose's & I fried their Well tube & spent. got a barrel of flour come home got back at 3 P.M. Don chores went to Creek got a barrel of mustard settled with Miss Rose to work making sink & firing well \$2.50 A filing Hand saw 10¢ Making Woods & West \$2.00 Balance due 60¢

wore at 5 Don chores went to Schreyer with team. Saw N.W. Wills Note for \$400.00 due in five years. Took up two Notes of \$227.42. Paid \$1.33 interest on the \$400.00 for 1 day drew \$171.25 from bank on Miller & Zimmerman check Paid Summer Fine \$15.00 Paid \$15.00 on Note due the C. D. Robinson estate. Paid \$3.00 to County & West on subscription on Sun. Paid for Dove \$1.25 for window & by 10 Pond 70¢ for lumber. Paid 60¢ for Dove Gick & iron. Paid 20¢ for iron comb. 15¢ for horses in Stable. I Denis got 2 fence Boards. got Home at 8 o'clock Paid 10¢ for affidavit on Post Office Papers etc. C. Bentwell finished his case ^{on Robinson}

Jan 13rd 1878 Sunday

Spoke at Home all day Don chores. Tricker pretended to Preach at the School House not many out. weather Pleasant. Helen used her Brush George at night writing at 9:30

Jan 14th Monday

Went to C. Oppsford got one shoe put on Dolls. did not ask the price. Then went to Becker Mill got a grist that I took there on the 3rd Paid 20¢ for Grinding 2 bushels of Corn. Then came ¹⁸⁷⁸ Home got there at 3 PM. Then went to Dennis got a barrel & filled it with water corn Home. Received a letter from Bill Mosh & wife the first in a year. Read paper till 10:30 then went to Bed.

Jan 15th Tuesday

Rise at day light don chores Breakfast at 8 then went got barrel of water at Bowes, then went to Husking Corn till noon. after dinner wrote for the Nebraska Farmer for J. P. Strong & myself sent two dollars in a letter. Sent for copies of Cincinnati Gazette.

when mail come I paid A. Holmes what was due the U. S. P. C. D. R. which was \$12.⁸³ ¹⁰⁰ for Incumbents then Husked Corn & don chores, retired at 10 P.M. P.D. Bonus \$1.00 stamp & one envelope 4c

Jan 16th 1878 Wednesday

a.m. Took Pig and went to Chamberlain to Boas, got Home at noon then Husked Corn for a while got water then went to Strong got a Boas Pig brought it Home put it in Pen. don chores. went to bed at 8:30

Jan 17th Thursday

Don chores. wrote an order for school money on County Treasures sent it to Babcocks got it signed by him Husked Corn and Don chores etc. Helen had the sick headache, retired

Jan 18th Friday

per bushel \$2.35 Paid \$4.35 for Hoop 35c
at 10c per pound got it of Wm Brown, the
Hoop to be paid for by the Auger Co. Paris
for Team & Hs. got home at 1 o'clock don chores
meeting at the school house.

Feb 8th 1878 Friday

Don chores and first a boat
Home went and got Bowes's Sythe
cut weeds got them to home don chores
at night went to meeting Babcock Preached

Feb 9th Saturday

a.m. Don chores then went to Bradford
to get some work done left it come home
Don chores &c it was cold & windy
retired at 10 o'clock. Babcock Preached &c

Feb 10 Sunday

Don chores stod at home all day
Tucker Preached not much of a
turn out Babcock & Preach in evening
cold & Pleasona.

Feb 11th 1878 Monday

Don chores and got weeds to burn.
got 5 keys and made and a hook mended
at C. O. Bradford do not know the price
I went to meeting in Evening so did
George & Minnie. Retire at 10 o'clock.

Tuesday

Don chores then went to Hardys got
chain come back first and got up the
Derrick. got ready to bore a well.
Deforest worked from 8th till 4 P.M.
in P.M. we boared eight feet deep I stood
at home in Evening let Mrs Rose have
a fine Wool Cap. we charged to her.
Call Babcock brought home my wagon
with one wheel broke. I retired at 10

Feb 13th Wednesday

Don chores then went to Boeing
worked from 8th till 4 PM A Deforest &
the help me got down 35 feet in all,
I don chores at night Helen sick
with Headache. George & Minnie went
to meeting at school house

Thursday

Don chores then boared on well
Deforest worked from 8 till 5. Chasly Bond
well worked from 8 till 5 I don chores retire

Feb 15th 1878 Friday

Don Chores &c Board on well
DeForest worked from 9 till 5 P.M.
H.W. Bakes worked from 10:30 till
Sundown, we got down 56 feet in all
I don chores Col Babcock got the
Spokes for my wagon wheel.
I retired at 8 P.M.

Feb 16 - Saturday

Don Chores &c then went to Boring
on the well DeForest worked from
9 a.m. till Sundown. Bontwell worked in
after noon got down 71 feet but the Cork
in. the sand so stiff it held it up. I let
the Hoses out to run they went to
Mrs Kosos & got all the quiet meetings
still gone on I retired at 11:30.

Feb 17th 1878 Sunday

Don Chores &c got ready went to
meeting at the School House Babcock
preached. I don chores at night
and stod at Home all day

Feb 18th Monday

Don Chores at noon started & went to Corlights got
his Sand Bucket got home at 3:30 first about the well don chores
at night stod at Home.

Feb 18 Tuesday

A.M. Don Chores at 9 DeForest come
& we went to Pumping out sand DeForest
stode till 4 O'clock we got the Cribbing
down and all out 4 feet of water
we took down the Derrick &c. His wife
was here. I sent for the Blade for \$1.25 strong
& one for J.D. Bowers \$2.50. I don chores at night

Feb 20 Wednesday

Don chores then went to Corlights
with Sand Bucket paid him one dollar for
the use of it. got home at 3 P.M.
DeForest come & got the Derrick & fixtures
I went to meeting at night at the
school house. Babcock preached.

Hog Pen. then dug out the spokes from
Wagon & tub don chores &c I sent to
Schmugles & got 14 feet of Iron $\frac{1}{2}$ Inch wide
DeForest paid for it 40 C. don chores &c

Feb 22 Friday

9 A.M. don chores at 9 O'clock went to Deford
& helped him Boar a saddle. come home
at 4 P.M. I don chores cold & rainy

Feb 23 1878 Saturday

Don chores in a.m. then went to DeForest & helped him Boor on well worked till 4:30 then come home & done chores &c. Sent to Collumons got Tea for 25¢ I sent \$5.00 to go Woods at Schuyler to apply on note sent it by C. O. Bradford

Feb 24 Sunday

Stode at home all day no one here Read paper &c the children went to meeting in Evening I shot up 5 Hogs in pen for fat.

Feb 25th 1878 Monday

a.m. don chores & just about till the morn come. at 10th then went to DeForest & helped him Boor on well got don. I came home to get tools to work on cabin went back & and worked till sundown then come home. Don chores &c made out paper for DeForest for his Rention. Let him have 3 stamps retured

Feb. 26th Tuesday

Don Chores then went to DeForest and worked worked on Cabining got it done come home. DeForest got 20 feet of Cabining of me all made to give me Boards in return,

Feb 27th 1878 Wednesday

a.m. don Chores then made wheel for well first all with well except Plowing 4 times around $\frac{1}{2}$ acres Don chores retured

Feb 28th Thursday

a.m. Plowed stubble for flag. in p.m. went and helped DeForest get in his corn got it in. then come home don chores &c retired at 10 o'clock. A Bridge come & I settled with him owe him \$8.25 for Stacking & Threshing

March 1st 1878 Friday

A.M. Went to DeForest's and Helped him Pump the sand out of his well got don at noon came home got water then went to Plowing Stubble for flag. don chores at night. Conrad children stode here while they were at Collumbus all night

March 2nd 1878 Saturday

Don chores am first about it stormed all day I Shiled corn & done a few spots don chores at night

March 3rd Sunday

Don Chores Stode at home all day Babcock Preached. I wrote & Lab Johnson, retired at 9:40

March 4th 1878 Monday

a.m. Don Chores & just a boat till
the mail come at 10. distributed it. then
gave Chamberlain my assessment ~~for~~
\$153.00 personal & in P.M. fixed Papers for
P Denise. 25c then finished putting the
wagon wheel together. in Evening
and till 11 O'clock. let P Bowes have the
blade for one year \$1.65 Bowes took the
corn sheller home with him

March 5th Tuesday

in a.m. Don chores fixed wagon when
there went to plowing after the mail
post went to plowing again at night
Burnt a fire broke & don chores
very pleasant day.

at 10 in P.M. Plowed near the house
with Bill & Tom to try the horse.
worked all night & tired at 10 o'clock

March 8th 1878 Friday

to Mrs Cooks and helped him
to get out his well curbing
worked till sun down. then com-
home don chores &c took George
Minnie & Mrs. Mosey. Mrs. Mosey come
and stode all night Helen not
feeling well but not sick.

March 9th Saturday

Don chores &c then went to Hovey
with the horses let P. Mosey take
Bill Horse & go and find him a
horse. I plowed all day for Mosey
Mosey had the horse of a day. at 50c

March 10th Sunday

Stode at Home all day. Preached
preached let Concord have 40 acres of long
& put in a crop Minnie went to DeForest & stayed

March 11th 1878 Monday

A.M. went to DeForest's got 15 bushels of Grass Seed got the forming mill and rod of George in P.M. went to Mr. Barnes' Shop got Plow share and 3 cleavers mat all cost 10c paid 4c

George went with me & got Home at dark

in AM. first & bout house to ready to work. in pm Plowed on Sec 17 for cold and windy

April 14th Sunday
