4. To explain the difficulties that the class can understand.

5. To train the pupil in original expression.

6. To build the character.

8. He must be a leader, or director of the recitation to or toward the point in view at the beginning of recitation. He also must often be a supplementer.

9. By promiscuous questioning. By making the each pupil responsible to the whole class for his answer.

10. They should have equal attention.

All pupils should be equal in the eyes of the teacher. If the quicker pupils grasp the thought first they should explain to the slower pupil as much as is possible. Their interpretation of the thought used in this way helps the slower to grasp the idea. It at the same time develops the powers of explaining and expression.

7. Written recitation is valuable for accurate and rapid thought and for mechanical exercise.

Oral recitations are valuable for originality.

1. Assignment of the lesson. 2. preparation of the lesson. 3. Recitation of the lesson.
2. 1. The text-book used. The subject and its relations to other lessons. The condition and relation of the learner's mind regarding the lesson matter about to be assigned.
3. Quality is more important than quantity. A lesson should be no longer than a pupil can prepare, review and associate with previous lessons with the study hour. The average pupil of the class should be the regulator.
4. The assignment of lessons by topics method may be used and is a good method for the grades above fifth gr and may be profitably used in the other grades as supplementary work.
5. Regquisition is preparing a lesson or rather measuring a lesson for recitation. Assimilation is the process of making the lesson a part of the permanent knowledge of the pupil.
6. 1. To find out what the pupil knows and how he knows it.
 2. To find out what the pupil does not know and why he does not know it.
 3. That the pupil may get a clear understanding of the lesson in terms of his own previously acquired experience
