





So all the Western infringers can do then, will be to cease manufacturing and pay heavy damages for past infringements, and as the owners will be equally liable, it would seem the part of prudence for them and responsible contractors to deal only with Hayes, the patentee, or with those (like ourselves) under license from him. By so doing, you get the best skylight and run no risks.





