I deeply appreciate the opportunity to discuss with you today some of our common problems.

In November we will have a clear choice, between two opposing philosophies of government. On the one hand we may continue an administration which would centralize in Washington all power over all details, of our individual lives; which practices unlimited spending, high taxes, and socialistic schemes destructive to the American system. On the other hand, we can choose a new Administration which believes in individual freedom, human dignity and basic Americanism, and offers a constructive, forward-looking program to restore these precious heritages to the American people.

This country has too long been torn by factionalism, and beset with emergencies arising out of the blunders of its national leadership.

The American people cry out for unity and they will be voting Republican this fall to obtain that unity. They know that unity begins at home, and that we must prove we can solve our many domestic problems in a spirit of unity, before we can hope to lead the world to a basis of international unity and a lasting peace.

Your Republican majority in Congress, since it assumed the legislative leadership two years ago, has worked unceasingly to restore honesty in government, efficiency and economy in the federal public service, and sanity, in the development of national policy

The task has not been easy. It has been complicated by Presidential vetoes and obstruction. But the record is good and the benefits are real.

I could enumerate a long list of Congressional achievements. But today I want to mention only those on agriculture.

We granted a permanent Federal charter to the Commodity Credit Corporation, the principal agency through which Government farm price-support activities are carried out. A long-range farm program was approved, including an extension of support prices for principal agricultural commodities. A complete, new crop-insurance program was inaugurated on a sound basis, with emphasis on local administration.

Mindful of the importance of electric power to farms and rural communities, Congress voted the largest funds ever provided for expansion of rural electrification. It provided for extensive construction of farm-to-market roads, and for a continuation of soil conservation work. We Republicans know that the prosperity of our nation depends upon the prosperity of agriculture.

All these things are vital to the welfare of Nebraska. But even more vital to us Nebraskans is the broader issue. Shall we retain our American form of government, or shall we let it be stolen away and sabotaged by those who would destroy America and all it stands for.

On November 2, the American people will answer this question. I predict they will, by an overwhelming majority, elect Thomas E. Dewey as President of the United States, Gov. Earl Warren as Vice-President of the United States, and will return to Congress a Republican House and Senate which will cooperate with the President to achieve the unity our nation so sorely needs.
