Memberships are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Membership Activation.

Your membership activates immediately upon purchase.
Please allow two (2) weeks for receipt of your membership card(s) in the mail.
You may visit before cards are received by providing front staff a valid photo ID.

About Membership Pricing and Benefits.

Pricing and benefits are effective for one year after the date of purchase.
History Nebraska reserves the right to change membership benefits or levels at any time.

One Household.

A household consists of two adults and all children under the age of 18; and legal wards who may be living at a separate address.

History Nebraska members who are grandparents may include grandchildren under the age of 18.

We ask that you refrain from sharing your membership with adult children or other adults outside of your immediate household.

Member Privacy.

Membership data may be shared upon formal, written request as established by Nebraska State Law, Neb. Rev. STAT. §§ 84-712 through 84-712.09.

Right to Revoke.

History Nebraska is a member organization committed to preserving history, respecting our historical collections, and one another. If we find that a member does not respect our environment, our rules, or others, we reserve the right to revoke their membership without refund.

Requirements to be a Member

A member shall be considered in good standing when the member has fulfilled all requirements for membership per state statute.

1. Request admittance into the society and provide, at minimum, a name and current address for their membership.
2. Be interested in the accomplishment of the purposes of the society:
 - a. To promote historical knowledge and research;
 - b. To awaken public interest in Nebraska History;
 - c. To popularize historical study throughout the state in a nonpolitical manner.

Claims.

Subscription and Household Plus members receiving the *Nebraska History* magazine are allowed to claim one replacement magazine per issue without charge.

Membership Levels

Each membership, excluding the Organization Subscription-Only Membership, receives one vote per membership in the History Nebraska Board of Trustees Elections. The ballot will be sent to the listed primary membership contact at their listed address. *All members who are entitled to cast a ballot must be active members of the society who are in good standing. A member shall be considered in good standing when the member has fulfilled all requirements for membership, listed above.*

Previous Categories of Membership

Two categories of membership no longer offered (Life and Joint Life-Spouse) shall continue to be recognized as valid and will convey benefits like the Household Plus membership, except that the Joint Life-Spouse shall continue to receive two ballots so long as both spouses are living. When one spouse is deceased, the remaining spouse will receive one ballot.
