The Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP) are recognized as the generally accepted appraisal standards. USPAP compliance for appraisers is required in federally-related transactions (Financial Institutions Reform, Recovery and Enforcement Act of 1989). State appraiser certification and licensing boards; federal, state, and local agencies, appraisal services; and appraisal trade associations require compliance with USPAP.
