Painting	Brenda and Alfredo by Ismael Linares - The support is a cotton-fiber canvas stapled to a four-member wooden strainer. The canvas was prepared with a white ground layer. Preliminary drawing was done in pencil and the painting was completed with acrylic medium colors. There is no varnish coating. L- shaped tear to right side.
Image	Photograph, pool hall - The object is a silver gelatin print on paper. It depicts a group of African-American men in a pool hall or bar with pool tables. Based on the dress of the men in the photo, particularly the two soldiers, the photo was likely taken in the early 1900s, probably the 1910s or '20s
