Scope and content

This collection consists of records created by the village of Bennington located in Douglas County, Nebraska. It consists of records likely originally held by the city clerk's office (see Custodial History note). Records include board of trustees minutes, ordinances, and ledgers, dating from 1892-1958. They are divided into two series by record type.

Conditions Governing Access

No restrictions. These records are public and open for use per Nebraska Revised Statute 84-712.01.

Custodial History

These records were donated by a private party who took them out of a dumpster. The records are considered separated because they left the chain of government custody. However, they still retain research value as historical documents.
